Rev. Fr. John Worjloh Mitchell hails from Liberia, West Africa, and has been in the ordained ministry for 13 years. Upon his graduation from the Gbarnga School of Theology, United Methodist University in February 2004, he was ordained a deacon in June at Trinity Cathedral. Fr. Mitchell served in Liberia at St. Augustine Episcopal Church (Gardnersville), the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd (Paynesville), and Grace Episcopal Church (Clay-Ashland) before coming to the United States. In May of 2016, he earned a Master of Divinity from Luther Seminary, St. Paul Minnesota.
